Subject: R. O. Korea's Activity Report for IRG meeting #38/June, 2012

Relevant documents:

1. R.O.Korea reviewed 9 characters out of 91 so-called 'Idu' characters. The K column of those 9 characters is empty. When R.O.Korea finds enough evidences for them, it may propose to extend them horizontally.
2. R.O.Korea discussed whether it is desirable to add total number of strokes in the proposal form for submission of new Hanja characters to WG2 or IRG. R.O.Korea decided to write and send to IRG a letter that the total number of strokes not be added in the proposal form.
3. R.O.Korea reviewed CJK ExtE v7.0 (IRG N1829) and v7.1 (IRG N1830) and sent comments whose document numbers are IRG N1829_ROKFeedback and N1830_ROKFeedback, respectively.
