According to IRGN 1791, we have submitted MASRG font (68 characters) to CJK Extension E. After email discussions with IRG Chief Editor and Technical Editor, the following 13 Macao characters were unified.

Afterwards, the MAC00034 ( 懿 ) was added in the CJK Extension E. Therefore, there should be 56 Macao characters remained in CJK Extension E. After comparing the 56 Macao characters with the Macao characters in IRGN 1830 (CJK Ext. E v7.1), we found that the following seven (7) characters are missing in IRGN 1830. We would be greatly appreciated if IRG helps to follow-up this, and we will provide any information if needed.
