
Information-technology Promotion Agency (IPA)

- Established as an "Incorporated Administrative Agency" based on the Low on Promotion of Information Processing (enacted May 22, 1970, Law No.90).
- 100% funded by Ministry of Economy, Trade and Industry (METI), Japanese government.
- Working with Ministry of Economy, Trade and Industry (METI) and other government organizations to realize and ensure secure and reliable IT environment..

2 registry systems of citizens

- 戸籍("Koseki"): registries under Ministry of Justis (MOJ)
 - Permanent records of families.
 - Own character set defined by MOJ
 - 55,266 ideographs
 - Mandatory for public administration use for human name by law
 - Independent from ISO / JIS
- 住民登録("Jumin-toroku"): registries under local governments (approx. 1,700), supervised by Ministry of International affairs and Communications (MIC)
 - Records of residences
 - Own character set defined by MIC
 - 19,563 ideographs
 - Independent from ISO / JIS

2 but virtually unlimited ideographic **P** character code set in Japan for citizen registry



(Character information development and maintenance project for egovernment) MOJ Ideograph set for "戸籍" Mandatory for public administration use (55,266 ideographs) MIC Ideograph set for "住民登録" (19,563 ideographs) ISO/IEC 10646 UCS / IVD

- All IT equipment for public administration to be available in market




- Building consolidated character / glyph set for public administrations in Japan

 - IPSJ (Information Processing Society of Japan)
 - JSA(Japanese Standards Association)
 - Consolidation of ideographs for public administration
