1. Review of CJK_F

Chinese experts reviewed CJK_Fv1.0, submitted comments and responses of comments, as required.

We noticed that there are 91 G-source glyphs not in Song Style (宋體), the new fonts will be submitted to IRG for reviewing after the 40th meeting.

We are considering to propose some characters, which are collected from ancient books published from dynasties from Song to Qing, by the Project “Chinese Characters Repertoire” (中華字庫), to the future CJK extension.

2. Recommendation of IRG Technical Editor

For internal reasons, the current IRG Technical Editor, Ms. Wang Xiaoming is not a member of Chinese delegation. China recommends Mr. Chen Zhuang, the IRG Chief Editor, to simultaneously take the work of IRG Technical Editor. See IRGN1941 please.
