 - ROK IRG committee discussed how to reduce # candidate chars to 4000 per project (e.g., ExtG). The conclusion is explained in IRG N1915.

 - ROK IRG committee discussed when and how to apply 5% rule defined in IRG PnP during IRG review process. The conclusion is explained in IRG N1915.

 - ROK IRG committee reviewed MBs' consolidated comments RE: ExtF. ROK's response is explained in IRG N1921_ROK_Response.

– ROK IRG committee notices that, in consolidated comments, some characters are shown WITHOUT source references while most characters are shown WITH source references.
