My suggestion for ROK is to consider to move K6-110B to U+2B058, that matches G-source glyph.

### 2. Discussion

1) As mentioned in Mr. Eiso's email shown in 1.3 above, there is no dot (stroke) in evidence for K6\_110B.



2) There is a dot in the glyph for K6-110B in KS  $\times$  1027-5. Therefore, there is a mismatch between the evidence in 1) and the glyph in KS  $\times$  1027-5.

3) As shown below, KR found another piece of evidence that matches the glyph for K6-110B in KS X 1027-5. (See the attachment 1 for the full text of evidence).




## 3. KR proposal

1) KR will modify the glyph for K6-110B in U+25A2B to match evidence. The source reference K6-110B remains unchanged.



2) KR will make a horizontal extension for the U+2B058. The source reference will be K6-1126.



3) KR will revise KS X 1027-5 by adding one character which matches the glyph for the U+2B058/GZJW-01380.



Note. The glyph of K6-110B in KS X 1026-5 will remain unchanged.
