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Resolutions of ISO/IEC JTC 1/SC 2 Plenary Meeting, Chiang Mai, Thailand, 2012-10-26

National bodies and Liaison organizations present at this plenary: Canada, China, Finland, Ireland, Japan, Sri Lanka, UK, USA, SEI – UC Berkeley, the Unicode Consortium

RESOLUTION M18-01: SC 2 Business Plan

SC 2 confirms the 2012 SC 2 Business Plan contained in SC 2 N 4253. SC 2 national bodies and liaison organizations are invited to provide information to be included in the 2013 Business Plan by 2013-08-31.

RESOLUTION M18-02: Endorsement of SC 2 Chairman

SC 2 endorses Dr. Yoshiki Mikami as its chairman for the second term of office. SC 2 Secretariat is instructed to forward this nomination to JTC 1 for appointment at the 2013 JTC 1 Plenary.

RESOLUTION M18-03: Continuation of OWG-SORT

SC 2 approves the continuation of OWG-SORT for the maintenance of ISO/IEC 14651 until the next SC 2 plenary with the following terms of reference:

- Incorporate the following changes in the latest edition of ISO/IEC 14651:
 - a new Common Template Table (CTT) for sorting all characters included in the third edition of ISO/IEC 10646 and its Amendments 1 and 2 (corresponding to Unicode 7.0) ;
 - corrections to the CTT to fix potential problems discovered since the latest official publication.
 - an informative annex summarizing the character string search problems (sub-product of the string comparison algorithm) that should contain a list of issues associated with implementation of collation, searching etc. and provide a pointer to UTS10 [decided at the 2012 Mountain View meeting]
- As interim results, produce:
 - a first working draft of Amendment 2 to ISO/IEC 14651:2012 synchronized with Unicode 6.2.1 (December 2012) and a second working draft, synchronized with Unicode 7.0, to be sent for PDAM 2 to ISO/IEC 14651:2012 ballot (after June 2013) meeting.

SC 2 re-appoints Mr. Alain LaBonte as the Convenor.

RESOLUTION M18.04: Subdivision Proposal for Amendment 2 to ISO/IEC 14651: 2011

SC 2 creates a subproject for Amendment 2 to ISO/IEC 14651:2011 as described in the terms of reference of OWG-SORT above. SC 2 delegates its authority to OWG-SORT for PDAM registration and further processing of this project until the next SC 2 plenary. SC 2 notes that the target starting dates are: PDAM 2013-10; DAM 2014-03; FDAM 2014-10.

SC 2 instructs its Secretariat to submit this subdivision proposal to JTC 1 for endorsement.

RESOLUTION M18.05: Progression of Project for Amendment 1 to ISO/IEC 10646: 2012

SC 2 endorses the disposition of comments in Document SC 2 N 4259 [WG 2 N 4346] on ISO/IEC 10646/DAM 1 developed by WG 2. SC 2 instructs its Secretariat to submit revised text of DAM 1 to ITTF for an FDAM ballot.

RESOLUTION M18.06: Progression of Project for Amendment 2 to ISO/IEC 10646: 2012

SC 2 endorses the disposition of comments in Document SC 2 N 4260 [WG 2 N 4377] on ISO/IEC 10646/PDAM 2.2 developed by WG 2. SC 2 instructs its Secretariat to submit revised text to ITTF for DAM processing. SC 2 notes that the target starting dates are DAM: 2012-11, FDAM: 2013-07.

RESOLUTION M18.07: Subdivision for the New Edition of ISO/IEC 10646

SC 2 creates a subproject for a new edition of ISO/IEC 10646 incorporating the text of Amendment 1 and 2 to ISO/IEC 10646: 2012 and further changes accepted by WG 2 as contained in the subdivision proposal in Document SC 2 N 4262 [WG 2 N 4382]. SC 2 instructs its Secretariat to submit this subdivision proposal to JTC 1 for endorsement.

RESOLUTION M18.08: Progression of the New Edition of ISO/IEC 10646

SC 2 instructs its Secretariat to initiate a CD ballot when text is submitted by the project editor. The ballot period (2, 3, or 4 months) will be decided by the project editor. SC 2 delegates its authority to WG 2 for further processing of this project until the next SC 2 Plenary. SC 2 notes that the target starting dates are CD: 2012-12, DIS: 2013-08, FDIS: 2014-03.
