RESOLUTION M 28-01: SC 2 Business Plan

SC 2 agrees that the Secretariat submits Business Plan to JTC 1 for the JTC 1 Plenary meeting to be held in November 2023 after comments from National Bodies and Liaison organizations are implemented as appropriate. SC 2 National Bodies and Liaison Organizations are invited to submit any comments on the draft Business Plan contained in SC 2 N 4864 to the SC 2 Chair by July 31, 2023.

RESOLUTION M 28-02: Succession Planning

In response to Resolution 14 - Succession Planning, adopted at the JTC 1 Plenary in May 2023, in Paestum, Italy, SC 2 agrees to start working on succession planning within SC 2.

RESOLUTION M 28-03: Consistency of International Standards

SC 2 reconfirms that it is critical for the International Standards to maintain their consistency, which should be respected by National Standards.

RESOLUTION M 28-04: Progression of ISO/IEC TR 2375

SC 2 instructs its Project Editor of TR 2375 to update the WDTR document with modifications pointed out by the members and to submit the updated document to the Secretariat for 8-week CDTR Consultation. SC 2 delegates its authority to the Project Editor for the responsibility of preparing a disposition of comments report on CD TR/DTR stages, a revised text and recommendation for further processing of this project until the next SC 2 Plenary. SC 2 notes that comment resolution by e-mail communication, or virtual meetings may be proposed by the Project Editor, if necessary. New target dates are CDTR: 2023-08-01, DTR 2023-12-01, TR 2024-08-01.

RESOLUTION M 28-05: Feedback on CJK Extension I

SC 2 invites the National Body of China to submit a document with comments on CJK Unified Ideographs Extension I to SC 2 by the end of June 2023, to incorporate changes into the next draft of

CDAM 2 prior to circulation for comments (WG 2 Recommendation M70.03).

RESOLUTION M 28-06: Progression of Amendment 2 to ISO/IEC 10646 (Ed. 6)
