On 1999-03-10, an ad-hoc group met to discuss the ballot results of FPDAM 14, Yi syllables and Yi radicals, in order to come up with recommendations for the disposition of comments so that Yi could progress to FDAM.

No National Body commented on the Yi syllables. The Chinese National Body and the UK National Body both indicated that there were errors in the numbering of entries in Annex E; the ad-hoc recommended that Annex E be revised and the errors corrected. Other editorial comments from the UK National Body were also endorsed for acceptance. The technical comment from both the Chinese National Body and the Irish National Body regarding YI RADICAL WO and YI RADICAL DU was accepted.

Extensive comments from the Irish National Body regarding the Yi radicals were discussed at length, and in order to resolve them, a reorganization of the Yi radicals was proposed in order to remove any possible contention.

The basic issue with the Yi radicals is that there are two contesting National Bodies with claims about them. The conclusion that the ad-hoc reached is the best way to resolve this with the highest level of consensus is to do three things:

- 1. Reorder the characters in A490–A4CF according to the order of the Yi radicals presented in Bburx 1984 and Bburx 1990, in accordance with the decision taken at the London meeting to reorder the Yi syllables according to their presentation in those same sources.
- 2. Remove the seven additional radicals (A49F YI RADICAL JY, A4B3 YI RADICAL LAVT, A4B7 YI RADICAL X, A4BD YI RADICAL VU, A4C1 YI RADICAL CI SSEP, A4C2 YI RADICAL YRRT, and A4C3 YI RADICAL VRRT) sponsored by the Chinese National Body for which there is no supporting evidence of their use apart from the statement (N1611) that they exist. Although the Irish National Body only requested the removal of four of these Yi radicals in the PDAM, it was considered safest also to remove A49F, A4B7, and A4BD at this time because no textual documentation has been provided showing their use as radicals.
- 3. Refrain from adding the five additional radicals (*A4A4 YI RADICAL ZZIP, *A4A5 YI RADICAL CYT, *A4B7 YI RADICAL NZUP, *A4C4 YI RADICAL ZUR, *A4C8 YI RADICAL NBIE) which the Irish National Body has shown to exist, while leaving holes in the encoding for their inclusion in a future amendment, pending consensus from interested parties that they should be added. This is similar to the compromise that was made for some contentious Myanmar vowels, where WG2 left holes but did not add them pending future study.

This compromise encodes the minimal set of Yi radicals that everyone agrees on; the holes are left for the radicals for which we have textual documentation, preserving the possibility for having a properly ordered set. Holes were not left for the unattested radicals, which could be added at the end if the set if required in future. The Ad-hoc group felt that this solution was the best approach for WG2 to take in order to progress to FDAM 14 and timely publication of Yi in the second edition of ISO/IEC 10646-1.

Addendum, 1999-03-23

A late comment from the Chinese National Body, not discussed by the Yi ad-hoc or by WG2 in Fukuoka, pointed out that there were in fact errors in the names list for the Yi syllables in the FPDAM: names for the characters in the range A3CA-A3D1 were incorrectly presented in the FPDAM. The names have been checked against Bburx 1990, confirming the Chinese National Body report. The editor of ISO/IEC 10646 considers the errors to be editorial, and the names will be adjusted in the FDAM to RUOX, RUOP, ROT, ROX, RO, ROP, REX.
