User Guidelines for Uyghur, Kazakh, Kyrgyz, and Chagatai

This document provides provides basic information on named sequences for use for the Uyghur and Chagatai languages.

Nine letters used in the Uyghur, Kazakh, Kyrgyz and Chagatai languages are represented by two-character sequences of encoded Arabic characters. Named sequences for these nine letters have been defined in Unicode. *However, they are not due to be published until the release of Unicode 6.3, scheduled for September 2013. Once published, they will appear in the NamedSequences.txt file in the Unicode Character Database.*

Details on the nine letters and the named sequences are listed below. The first line of each entry below gives the letter name familiar to users.

Medial forms of Uyghur letters:

As is typical for other languages written using Arabic script, Uyghur letters have alternate presentation forms depending on word context. Named sequences are not defined for medial

forms of letters such as Uyghur letter I () or Uyghur letter E (). Nevertheless, font and rendering-engine implementations are expected to support medial forms of these letters, as would be done in any implementations that support Arabic script.

Keyboards:

Although the letters are represented by multi-character sequences, users perceive these letters as integral elements. Keyboard implementations may wish to provide single keystroke actions to enter each of these letters.
