# Proposal to encode the DOGRA VOWEL SIGN VOCALIC RR $\,$

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#### 1 Introduction

This is a proposal to encode a new character in the Dogra script. The details of the character are given below.

# 2 Description

Vowel sign Vocalic RR appears to have been introduced as part of New Dogra. It is used for representing words of Sanskrit origin that contain the sound  $\bar{\mathfrak{r}}$ . Since there are no corresponding independent vowel letters for  $\bar{\mathfrak{r}}$  and  $\bar{\mathfrak{l}}$ , these letters are also written as a combination of ra/la and VOWEL SIGN VOCALIC RR. It corresponds to U+111B9 SHARADA VOWEL SIGN VOCALIC RR and U+0944 Q DEVANAGARI VOWEL SIGN VOCALIC RR.

#### 3 Reallocation

Currently DOGRA VOWEL SIGN E is allocated at U+11832. VOWEL SIGN VOCALIC RR character is proposed at U+11832 to keep uniformity in the order of alphabet. The current code points of the characters and the requested reassignments are:




Figure 1. A page from Vyavahar Gita printed at Shri Raghunath Ji Press, Jammu in 1884 shows  $\bar{r}$  and  $\bar{l}$  written as a combination of ra/la and VOWEL SIGN VOCALIC RR (from Sharma, 1976).




Figure 2. A manuscript showing  $\bar{r}$  and  $\bar{l}$  written as a combination of ra/la and VOWEL SIGN VOCALIC RR.
